



Current Population Survey (CPS) – 2006

These summary data from the 2006 CPS online microdata files are inclusive of **civilian workers, 15 years of age or older**, who are identified as being “**Employed–At work**” or “**Employed–Absent**”. The tables provide national estimates for counts and full-time equivalent (FTE) workers.^{1,2,3} Also provided is the percent change from the year 2005.
